TO: RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES OF BAYNE CRESCENT / LONDON STREET ALLEY

RE: 2026 LOCAL STREETS RENEWAL AND ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PATH – BAYNE CRESCENT / LONDON STREET ALLEY - ALLEY BLOCK BOUNDED BY BAYNE CRES, LONDON ST, TU-PELO AVE AND BAYNE CRES

We are planning alley construction on the Bayne Crescent / London Street Alley this summer.

Construction start window: July to October 2026
Duration: Approximately 2-4 weeks, weather permitting

We will:

- Repair alley pavement as required
- Adjust underground infrastructure surface features (i.e. manhole and catch basins)
- Restore boulevards as required

During construction:

- The alley will be closed to through traffic and construction will be phased.
- Garbage and recycling collection will be relocated to the front street.
- We will maintain pedestrian access to all properties

- Underground appurtenances such as sprinkler systems or lighting cables within six metres (20 feet) of the curb
